AutoCAD 2017 is an electronic publishing application. The name implies that AutoCAD is a replacement for a desktop publishing package, which was usually separate from a CAD or DFM (design for manufacture) software package. AutoCAD can also be used as a spreadsheet or graphing program. In many ways, the desktop publishing metaphor still applies to AutoCAD, but it has always been integral to AutoCAD's development. AutoCAD is used by architects, landscape architects, civil engineers, mechanical engineers, architectural and interior designers, and many other engineering and design professionals. AutoCAD is also used by engineers and architects at commercial, government, and academic design and construction sites. AutoCAD is sometimes referred to as AutoCAD/Civil 3D by Civil 3D. It is not uncommon for models to be annotated in multiple languages (more than one language can be used at the same time). A model may be exported to a dxf file, bdd file, svf file, dgn file, stl file, or a variety of other formats. In addition, a model may be exported to a Microsoft Word or PDF file. AutoCAD is a line-based application. Objects are represented by lines, paths and arcs. When the first version of AutoCAD was released, only lines and arcs were represented as objects, and the paths used by most users today were introduced in AutoCAD R13. Both these paths and the paths of previous versions are created by drawing them as lines, and then converting them to paths. For example, to create a path, the user draws it in the object palette, and then "make path". If the user desires to convert that path to a path, then in the object palette, select the path, and click "convert to path". A number of alternate conversion methods are available for path creation and modification. An example is the "subdivide tool". With this tool, the user draws one or more line segments on the drawing canvas, selects them, and hits the "subdivide" button on the tool bar. The segments are then converted into a path. AutoCAD is a significant development for Autodesk. AutoCAD R13 was the first Autodesk program to use features from the then-new Inventor software. The first version of Inventor was released in 1990. Later, the development of AutoCAD was driven in part by a desire to provide a single product to CAD users. AutoCAD was one of the first CAD packages to provide a choice of modeling tools, as a way to accommodate the desire for variety among users. Since then, AutoCAD has gained the ability to use any file format

You can interact with AutoCAD through the Markup application, a third-party application that lets you add changes to a drawing. This helps you address changes during design reviews, or incorporate feedback from a presentation, web conference, or other source. The Markup app lets you import feedback from paper or digital (PDF) files in just a few easy steps. You can also add comments to your design as you work, with the ability to select or deselect comments as you go. After you import the comments, the app automatically detects which ones have been accepted by the designer and which ones have been rejected. You can then approve or reject the comments and give feedback in response to the comments. You can approve or reject comments in groups or one at a time. You can also use the Markup app to create a markup template that includes other comments. You can then copy the template to other drawings and send it to the designer.
